

Article I

Name

The Name of Club will be: Data Science Club

Article II

Purpose of the Club

The club has been organized to:

Create an on-campus community of students who share an interest in data science and other related fields .

Introduce students to the fundamentals of data science such as Python and R through beginner-friendly workshops and hands-on projects.

Support students who plan to transfer to four-year universities for data science or related majors by offering resources and guidance.

Article III

Authority

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

Article IV

Membership

Membership is open to all SBCC Students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

Article V

Meetings

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC 217.

Article VI

Officers

President - Oversees all club meetings, sets goals for the club, coordinates activities, and serves as the primary representative of the club.

Vice President - Assist the president, helps coordinate events, and oversees internal communication and engagement among members.

Curriculum Coordinator - Develops educational material, coordinates and leads workshops, provides resources for academic and career guidance.

Treasurer - Manages the club's expenses, organizes fundraising events, develops a budget for the club.

Outreach Officer - Promotes the club, builds relationships with student organizations, represents the club at external events, organizes partnerships, and designs engaging content for social media.

Article VII

Elections

Officers shall serve one term and will be elected each fall semester.

Article VIII

Amendments

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 75% of the Club members.
