

SBCC Veterans Club

ARTICLE I

(Name of Club)

The name of this Club will be SBCC Veterans Club.

ARTICLE II

(Purpose of Club)

The club has been organized to bring together student veterans and dependents on campus with each other and the greater student body in order to create a sense of community; and to connect veterans with veteran organizations such as the VFW, American Legion, AMVETS, etc.. within the local community.

ARTICLE III

(Authority)

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate (ASG), the Office of Student Life, and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IV

(Membership) (Mandatory)

Membership is open to all SBCC students regardless of their veteran status, religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

ARTICLE V

(Meetings)

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC-217.

ARTICLE VI

(Officers)

President – Preside over all meetings, call special meetings, and plan/organize events.

Vice President – Supports presidents, takes over in the president's absence, manages social media/marketing.

Treasurer – Keeps financial record, maintains receipts, initiates refund processes with the Office of Student Life, requests money from student government (ASG), and runs fundraising.

All officers are meant to contribute to ideas/event creation.

ARTICLE VII

(Elections)

Officers shall serve one term(s) and will be elected each Fall and following Spring Semester, i.e. Fall 2019-Spring 2020, Fall 2023-Spring 2024, etc...

Officers shall not be elected to serve more than two consecutive terms.

ARTICLE VIII

(Amendments)

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 55% of the Club members and 2/3rds of the cabinet.
